



*The Nova Scotia College of Nursing (NSCN) is the regulatory body for licensed practical nurses (LPNs), registered nurses (RNs) and nurse practitioners (NPs) in Nova Scotia. Our mandate is to protect the public by promoting the provision of safe, competent, ethical and compassionate nursing services by our registrants. The term nurse in this document refers to LPNs, RNs and NPs unless otherwise stated.*

Immunizations have a significant and positive impact on the health of our population. Widespread vaccination shortens the duration of disease outbreaks, maintains public safety, reduces the burden on the health care system and keeps health care providers safe to care for clients in need.

The Nova Scotia College of Nursing (NSCN) recommends that nurses be vaccinated against COVID-19 and encourages nurses to use current science-based sources and their knowledge, ethical frameworks as the foundation for their decision. NSCN also recommends that any decision to require nurses to be vaccinated should be made by nurses and employers in consideration of the practice context.

## COVID 19 Vaccine Administration: Key Regulatory Facts

- Administering the COVID-19 vaccine is within the scope of practice of all nurses, as well as other health care providers.
- Nurses with the appropriate knowledge, skill and judgment may administer the COVID-19 vaccine.
- An authorizing mechanism, such as a direct order, policy, practice guideline, care directive or standard operating procedure, is required to enable nurses to administer the vaccine.
